

Insert recorded videos

Reasons to add your own recorded videos to your course:

- Place a welcome video in the Introduction section of your course.
- Include short explanations about what students can expect in each unit in the introduction to each unit.
- Add lectures.
- Demonstrate how to complete a task.


Best methods to insert recorded videos into your Moodlerooms course:

- [Upload directly to the Moodlerooms website](#). This is a good option if you have only a few videos to place in your course. Otherwise, your course file becomes too large, takes up too much space on our Moodlerooms server, and will not allow you to make a backup and use the course for another semester. *(Our course files are limited to 500 Mb in size.)*
- [Upload to the Yuja website](#) and insert a hyperlink to it in your Moodlerooms course. **This is the best method** if you have several videos since the previous method can cause your course file to become too large.
- Upload to YouTube and insert a hyperlink to it in your Moodlerooms course. This is okay to use as long as you have uploaded the recordings as "private" recordings. *(We must be cautious of public access.)*

Upload directly to the Moodlerooms website.

To insert a recorded video directly into your Moodlerooms course, either add a label resource or use any text editing window already in your course. For instance, a good place to put a welcome video is in the Introduction section of your course. You might even include short lectures in the introduction to each unit.



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
Once you are in the text editing window and have placed your insertion point where you want the video to appear, click the **Insert Media button**.

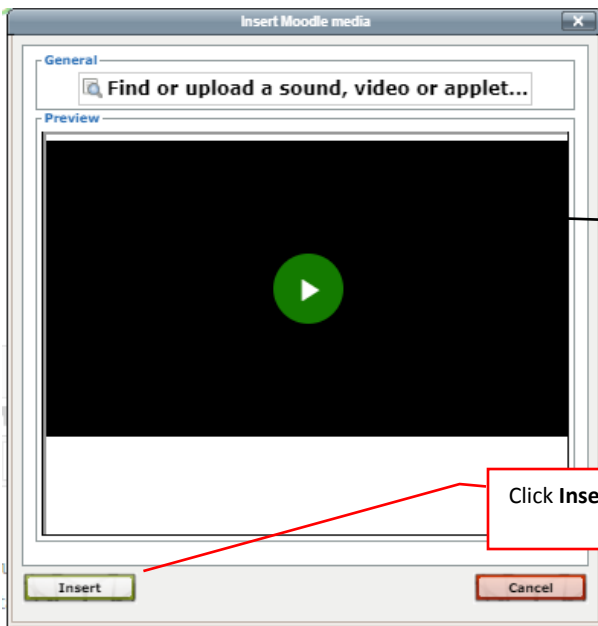
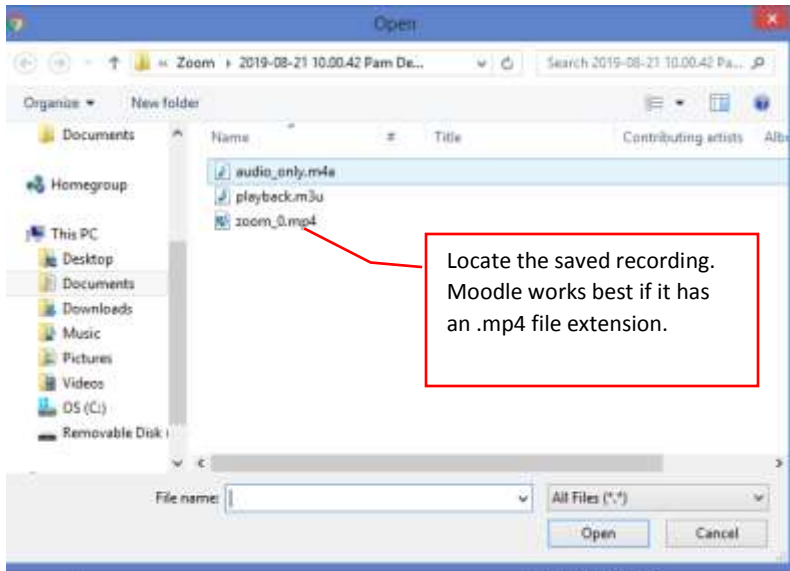

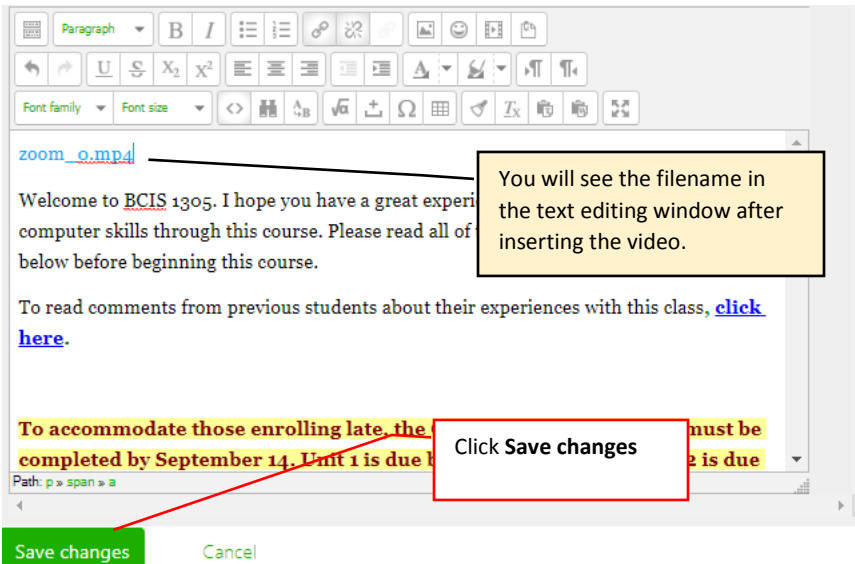

This is what you will see next.

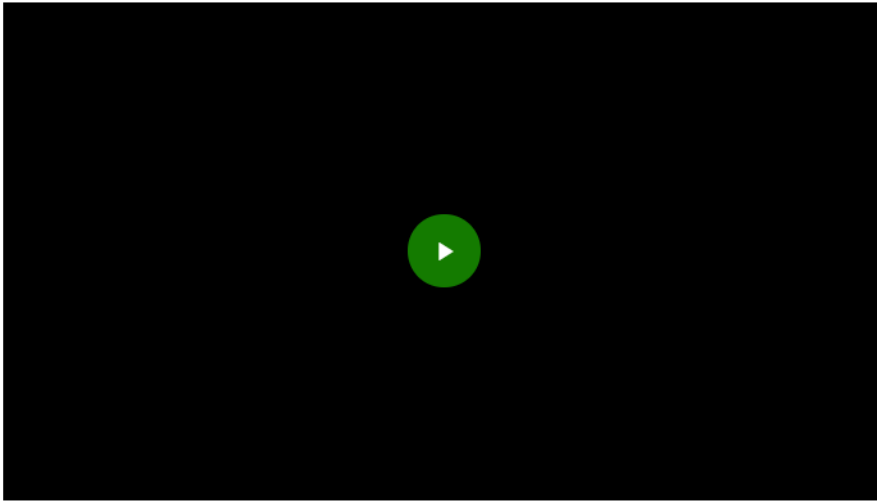


You will see the filename in the text editing window after inserting the video.
