

Recommended Book resource settings

Book resource

A book resource allows an instructor to "chunk" a lot of information on to separate pages (called "chapters") so students can better absorb it. This is a good way to present additional information not found in the textbook.

Students click on each "chapter" to read the information.

Chapters

1. Page 1
2. Page 2
3. Page 3

With the proper settings the Activity completion icon will change to a green check mark once students click on each chapter in the book.

Click the **Edit** icon below the URL resource to open the Edit settings screen.
