


## Recommended Page resource settings



**Page resource**

A Page resource is used to provide information that may be fairly long. Instead of having all of it appear on the main screen, it shows the first few lines and has a "Read more" button to click to



After changing settings always click the "Save and return to course" button on the left side of the Edit settings screen.
