File resource

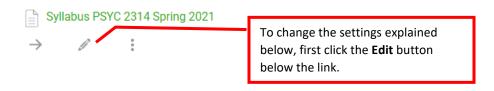
The file resource is the best way to provide a link to a single saved file. It can be any type of file. To insert a file resource on a course page:

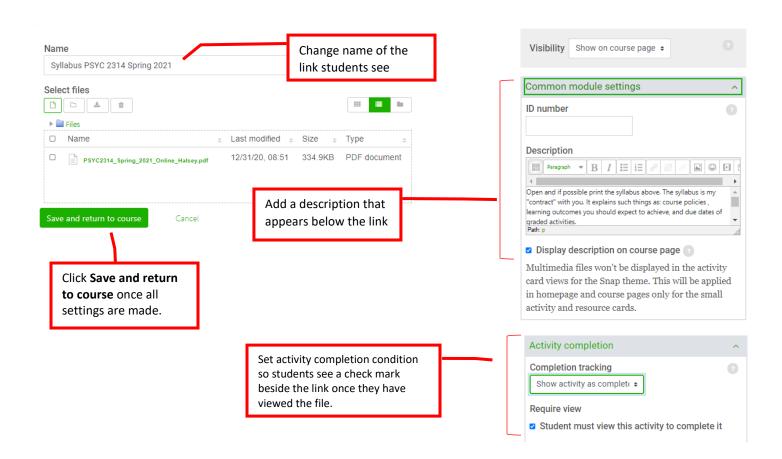
- 1. It is best to first be in the section of the course where you want the link to appear.
- 2. Then choose one of the methods shown below to add the file resource. (These choices are located at the bottom of each section in your course.)



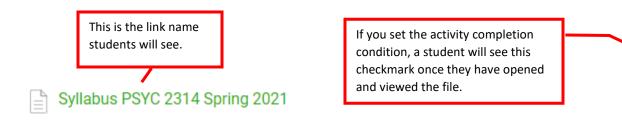
Once the file resource is inserted into the section, you can <u>move it</u> to where you want it to appear in the section (or even to a different section).







What students see



Open and, if possible, print the syllabus above. The syllabus is my "contract" with you. It explains such things as: course policies, learning outcomes you should expect to achieve, and due dates of graded activities.

In the Class Orientation section you will "sign" your name on the Syllabus Agreement EVA, showing that you understand and agree to abide by what is in the syllabus. Therefore, it is important that you read the syllabus carefully.
