

Grading forums with multiple rubrics and feedback

Below is an example of what you could place in an Advanced grading marking guide type of rubric if you want to have multiple criteria in a forum activity and not just have a place to put student feedback while grading. Example shows 75 points for the student posting correctly and 25 points for replying correctly.
