

## Use Assignment activity with groups

*Example: A group is developing a PowerPoint presentation together. One group member uploads a PowerPoint slideshow they started. Another group member downloads it, improves and re-uploads it to the same common assignment area. Group members can leave comments to each other in the Online textbox area (if enabled). They continue working on the slideshow until the group has agreed on the completed slideshow to submit for a grade.*

When grading, the teacher may choose to give a common grade and feedback to all students in the group or to give individual grades and feedback to each member.

Choose whether students will collaborate only in the Online textbox area or be able to upload a file for other group members to download, improve, and re-upload to the common assignment area.
