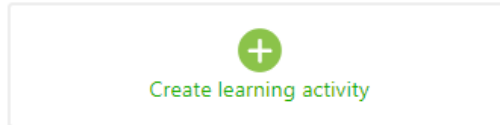


URL resource

The URL resource provides a link to a web page. To insert a URL resource on a course page:

1. It is best to first be in the section of the course where you want the link to appear.
2. Then choose “Create learning activity” (located at the bottom of each section in your course) to add the URL resource.



Once the URL resource is inserted into the section, you can [move it](#) to where you want it to appear in the section (or even to a different section).
